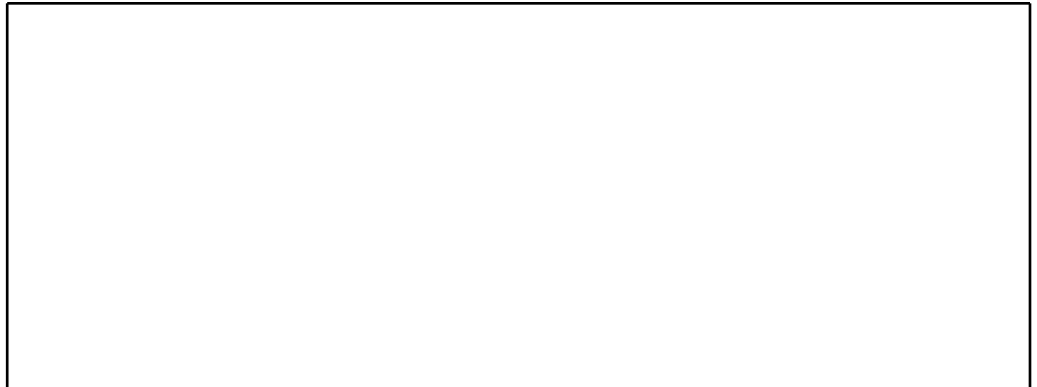
The space flanks the left side of a commercial building alley in the old district of Psirri. The entrance alley is wide open by day and closed at night by an iron mesh curtain. A flight of stairs preceding the space leads to the basement; behind the space, there is a small reception desk, an elevator and a flight of stairs going to the upper floors. The end of the alley houses a typical greek coffee shop run by a friendly old couple. Neighbors on the street include a glazier's shop, a ribbon's shop, a haberdasher and a stationary shop.

The structure of the space is made of painted metal creating four glassed panels, three on the long side and one in front. The door panel is narrower than the other two. The opposite long side is a solid wall while the short back side and the ceiling are of chip wood. The floor is a marble mosaic. If you need more information please email project@d624.org.
